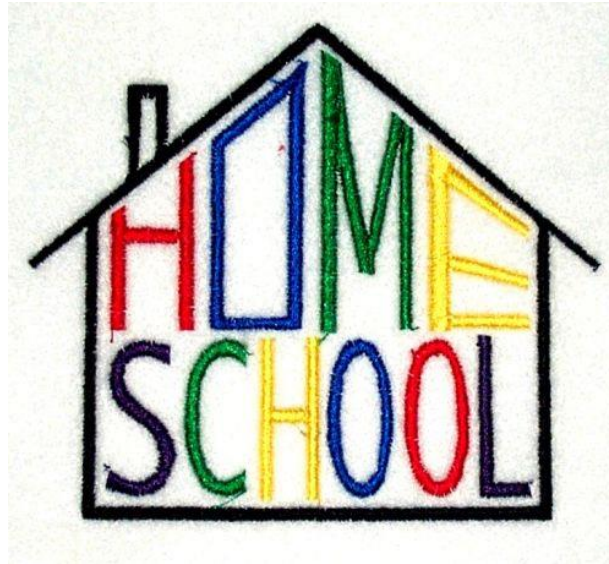




Year 2 Home Learning Pack

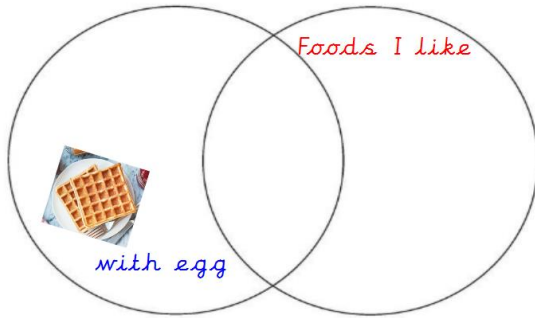
When was Easter on the year you were born? How old would you have been in months, weeks or days?

Can you solve these word problems? Show your working out.

Can you write any for someone else to solve?

No need to print off the problem, just read and have a go!



The Easter Bunny has 12 eggs in his basket. 3 fell out on the way to the 'Great Egg Hunt'. How many does the Easter Bunny have now?

The Easter Bunny has 8 eggs in his basket. It then puts 5 more in his basket. How many does the Easter Bunny have now?

The Easter Bunny wants to put each of his eggs in a box, which cost 10p. It has 6 eggs. How much will it need to spend?

The Easter Bunny has 5 boxes that it needs to fill equally with his 60 eggs. How many eggs will go in each box?

The Easter Bunny buys an Easter egg for 12p and an Easter card for 27p. How much did it spend?

The Easter Bunny starts off with 20 eggs in his basket. At the first house it drops off 7 eggs, and at the second house it drops off 5. How many eggs are in his basket now?



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The Easter Bunny has 27 eggs in his basket. 13 fell out on the way to the 'Great Egg Hunt'. How many does the Easter Bunny have now?

The Easter Bunny buys a new basket for £1.45 and an Easter card for 27p. It pays with a £2 coin. What change does it get?

The Easter Bunny starts off with 50 eggs in his basket. At the first house it drops off 27 eggs, and at the second house it drops off 15. How many eggs are in his basket now?

The Easter Bunny has 243 eggs in his basket. It then puts 128 more in his basket. How many does the Easter Bunny have now?

The Easter Bunny has 5 boxes that it needs to fill equally with his 75 eggs. How many eggs will go in each box?

The Easter Bunny buys a new basket for £1.45 and a pack of Easter card for £2.27. It pays with a £5 note. What change does it get?



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The Easter Bunny starts off with 50 eggs in his basket. At the first house it drops off 27 eggs, and at the second house it drops off 15. He then decides he doesn't have enough so buys another 33. How many eggs are in his basket now?

The Easter Bunny has 103 eggs in his basket. 47 fell out on the way to the 'Great Egg Hunt'. How many does the Easter Bunny have now?

Once you have an ebook, or a book from your own home...

1. What type of book was it, fiction or non-fiction?
2. Read with expression, taking account of punctuation.
3. Retell what you have just read, in your own words.
4. Look at the language use, spot; adjectives, nouns, adverbs. Make a list, are there any words you could think of an alternative?

E.g. When Winnie the Witch **turned** over the page on her calendar, she **saw** a **big red circle** around Friday the thirteenth.



When Winnie the Witch *flicked* over the page on her calendar, she *spotted* a *huge scarlet ring* around Friday the thirteenth.

Write a diary entry

This would have been your last week at school before the Easter holiday. We have never had a situation like this before, keep a daily diary to record it.

Share a story

Read to your child, so they can access stories beyond their own reading level.
