African elephants mainly eat grass and plants but they also like to eat fruit.

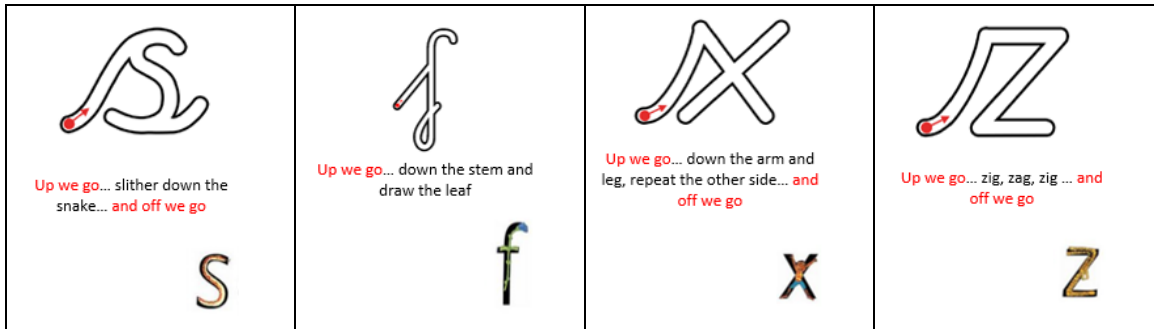
### Amazing Facts

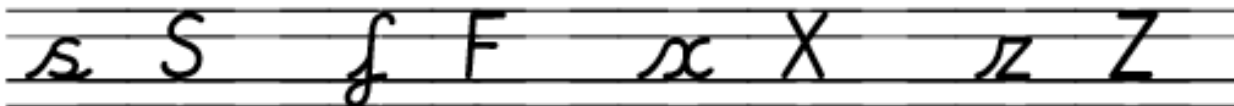

Make sure you are forming your letters correctly - say the phrases as you write each letter.

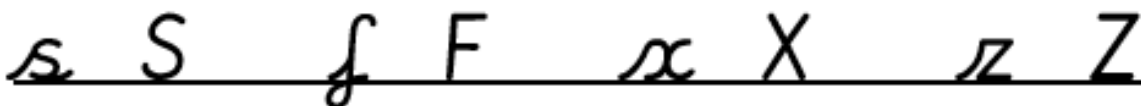


Capital letters are tall, they always touch the top of the handwriting lines.

Here's how they sit on 'normal' lines.





The x should be straight - unfortunately this font shows it with curved lines.



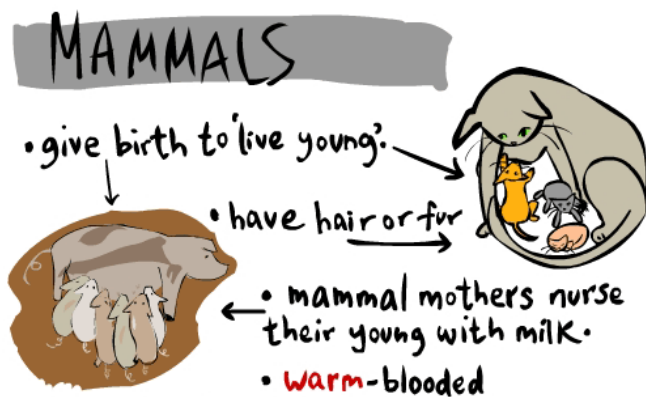
In year one we focus on doubles up to 20, the second game goes up to 30 (double15).

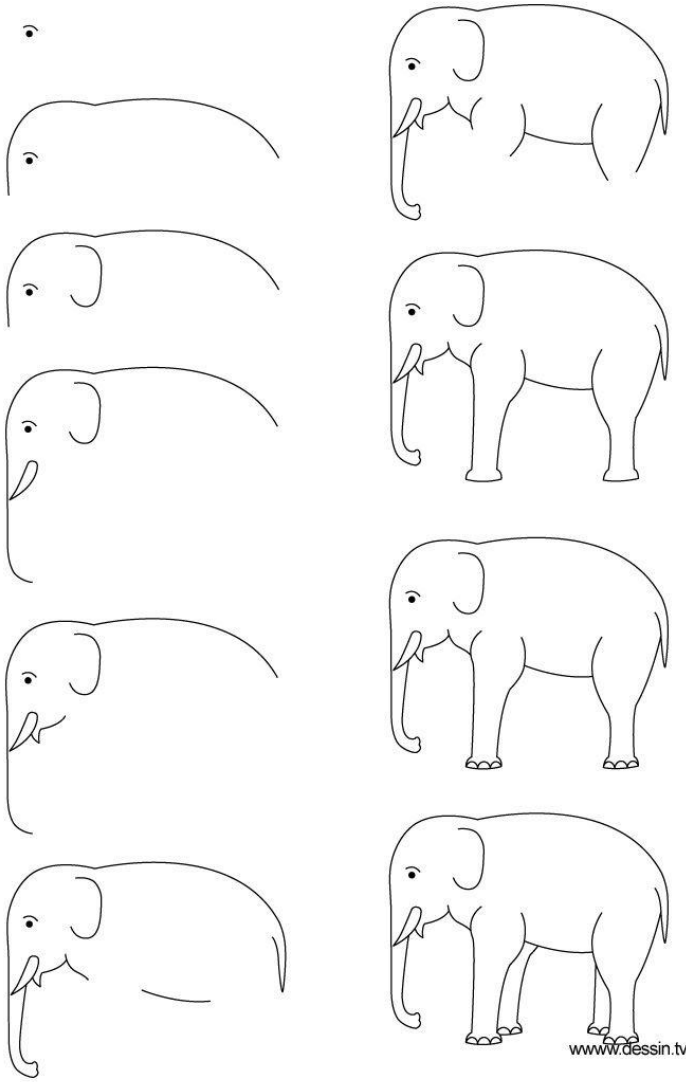
